Regular Meeting
Spur Independent School District, Board of Trustees
March 23, 2009

The Spur Independent School District Board of Trustees held their Regularly Scheduled meeting on Monday, March 23, 2008, at 7:00 P. M. Five members of the Board were present Lance Harris, Barry Ferguson, Lacy Loudermilk, Rick Paschall, and Shane Shobert. Principal's Nick Scott and Charles Bryant were present and provided a report of recent and upcoming activities on each campus.

The Board honored and expressed their support and appreciation for several Spur High School students who have advanced to State and National competitions in BPA. Those present at the meeting representing BPA were sponsor, Debbie Ball, and the following students, Brooke Ferguson, Dakota Tilton, Lindsay Ayers, Courtney Norris, Bailey McCormick, Julie Foster, Casey Hale, and Cole Clark.

The minutes were approved from the Regular Meeting on February 23, 2009. Business Manager, Tonya Rudd, made a presentation of the bills, utilities, investments, and bank reconciliations.

Eric Swenson of Spur Security Bank made a presentation to the board regarding the current property values within the school district and recommended to the board that this is an opportune time to continue considering further facility improvements to the Spur ISD fiscal plant. The Board held a lengthy discussion on the current facilities and what should be considered priorities.

The Board took formal action on three items. The Board voted unanimously to cancel the May trustee elections. There are two places open and the candidates for each place are running unopposed. The Board took final action on the policy review conducted by TASB Policy Services. All policies were repealed and reinstated as had been recommended by the Board to TASB Policy Service.

At the conclusion of closed session, the Board approved professional contracts as presented with one teacher being pulled and acted on separately. The Board voted to terminate the probationary contract of Katherine Hester, high school math teacher.
