Spur Independent School District, Board of Trustees
April 27, 2009

The Spur Independent School District Board of Trustees held their Regularly Scheduled meeting on Monday, April 27, 2008, at 7:00 P. M. Five members of the Board were present, Lance Harris, Barry Ferguson, Robert Van Meter, Rick Paschall, and Shane Shobert. Charles Bryant provided a secondary principal report, Lenny Morrow provided a report on the Bulldog and Spurette athletic department, and Earl Jarrett provided a report on happenings at the elementary campus.

The Board honored the Spur FFA Meats Judging and Horse Judging teams for advancing to the state competition. The Meats Judging team members are Melissa Valenzuela, Candice Goodall, Anthony DeLeon, and Matt Zint. The Horse Judging team was made up of Zach Harston, Tanner Arnold, Cole Clark, and Landon White. Ag teacher, Kermit Woolley, trained and prepared both of these teams.

The minutes were approved from the Regular Meeting on March 23, 2009. Business Manager, Tonya Rudd, made a presentation of the bills, utilities, investments, and bank reconciliations.

The Board went on a tour of the Spur ISD fiscal plant to aide in developing priorities for continued improvement of the fiscal plant.
