Regular Meeting
Spur Independent School District, Board of Trustees
May 25, 2009

The Spur Independent School District Board of Trustees held their Regularly Scheduled meeting on Monday, May 25, 2009, at 7:00 P. M. All six current members of the Board were present, Ricky Martinez, Lance Harris, Barry Ferguson, Robert Van Meter, Rick Paschall, and Shane Shobert. The Board honored all Spur High School students who qualified for Regional competition in Academic UIL and track.

The minutes were approved from the Regular Meeting on April 27, and the special meeting held on May 11, 2009. Business Manager, Tonya Rudd, made a presentation of the bills, utilities, investments, and bank reconciliations.

The Board continued discussion on future facilities upgrades and a potential candidate to be appointed to take the place of resigned board vice president, Lacy Loudermilk. The first action taken was to issue the Oath of Office to elected Board member Barry Ferguson. The Board issued a certificate of election for the May 9, 2009, election. The leadership of the Spur ISD Board was reorganized; Ricky Martinez was re-elected President, Barry Ferguson was elected Vice-President, and Shane Shobert will continue to serve as Secretary. The Board took action to approve participation on the Region 17 Trillion Project for internet access. The Board approved using funds remaining from the Spur ISD construction project to replace the field house at Jones Stadium. The Board approved TASB (LOCAL) Policy Update 85 with recommendations for DEC (LOCAL).

In other action, the Board approved the hiring of Travis Breitschopf as the Spur Elementary Principal and Matthew Billings as middle school social studies teacher and coach.
